### FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

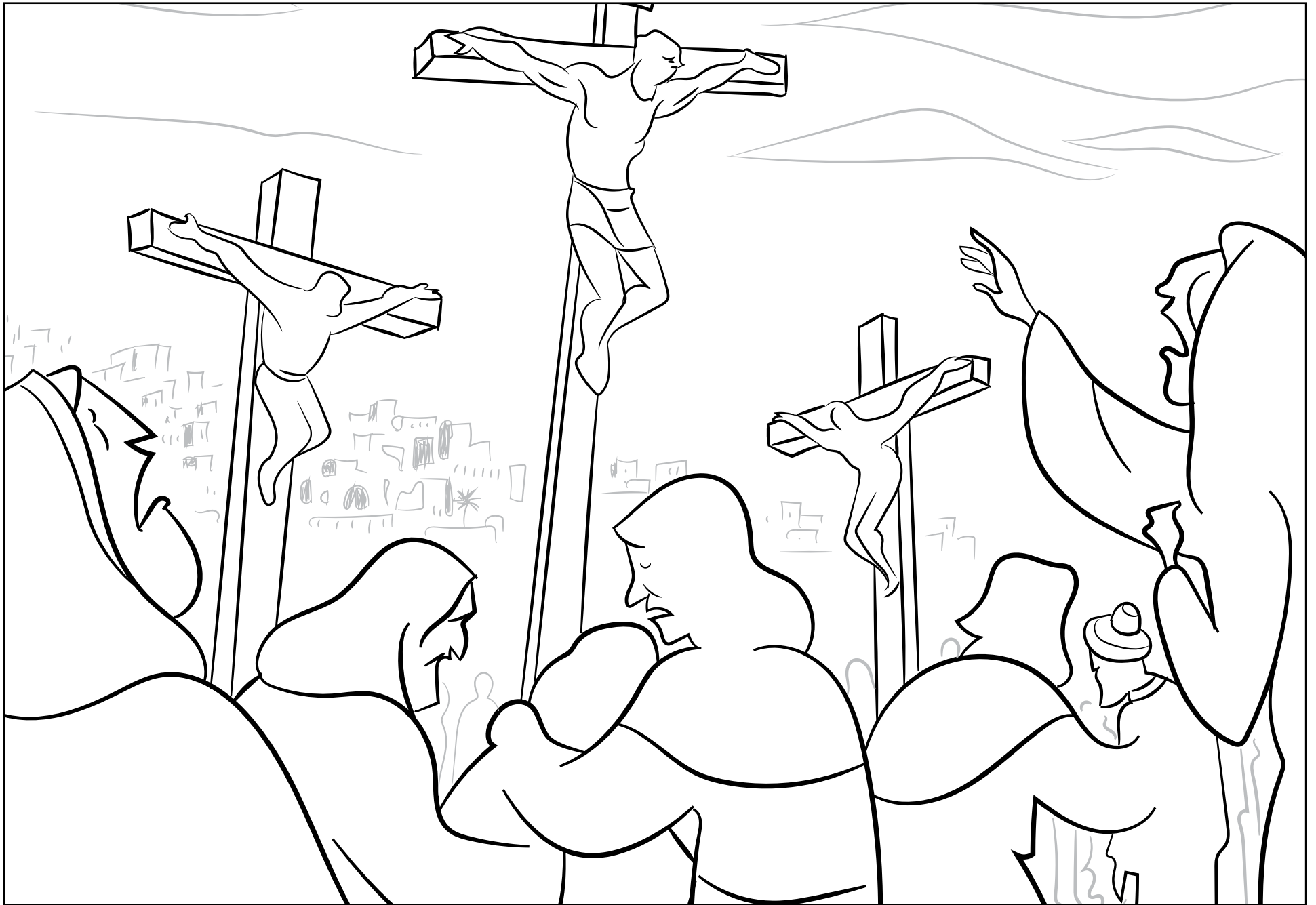
- Why did Jesus have to die on the cross?
