

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

Scripture

1 Corinthians 15:1-11,20-22

Session Summary

When Paul was in Corinth, he preached the gospel, the good news. Paul did not dream up this story; he heard it and believed it, and he turned around with what he had received and told anyone who would listen about who Jesus is and what He has done. Paul wanted us to understand the link between Jesus' resurrection and our hope. Because Jesus lives, we know that we too will live. Because Jesus defeated death, we know that death doesn't have the final word over us.

Conversation Questions

- What aspect of the gospel is the hardest to truly believe?
- Why does knowing the gospel change the way our family lives?
- How does the resurrection provide us hope? When have we needed hope recently?
- Who can our family share this hope with this week?

Family Challenge

Easter often brings about different fun family traditions, including Easter baskets and egg hunts! But, don't forget to take time as a family this week to read about and reflect on the death and resurrection of Christ. Discuss as a family how you can make Christ the focus of your annual traditions.
