UNIT 28 | CHRISTMAS

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

Scripture

John 1:10-18

Session Summary

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us so that we might have grace and truth. Jesus came not only to provide us with salvation, but also with a perfect example of how to live. We are called, like Jesus, to go out among those who don't know God's grace and truth, so that those separated from God would be restored to see, hear, and experience the gospel to be saved. This is at the heartbeat of what is meant by incarnational living.

Conversation Questions

- How can we make Christmas more about Jesus coming to earth and less about gifts and traditions?
- Why do you think God sent Jesus to dwell among us when He could've done it any other way?
- How should we respond in worship when we think about such things?
- In what ways can we position ourselves around people who need to know about Jesus?
