

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

Scripture

Luke 4:1-13

Session Summary

The first temptation that Jesus faced had to do with His identity as the Son of God—a question of the affirmation He just heard at His baptism. But, Jesus chose spiritual priorities over the desires of his flesh. He fought back against temptation using the Word of God. In this second temptation we see that Jesus is tempted to believe that God is withholding from Him. For the final temptation, Jesus was taken to a mountain. Mysteriously, here Jesus had a glimpse of all the kingdoms of the world at once. Satan's goal was for Jesus to worship him in order to receive power. But, Jesus clung to God's Word once again and rested in the promise that His glory would flow from His identity as the Son of God.

Conversation Questions

- What are some trials that our family has gone through together?
- How did God comfort us and lead us during those trials?
- What are some weapons that God has given us to fight against temptation?
- Why can we always know that God's Word is faithful and trustworthy?
