Discussion Questions

 **1** **Read Col. 3:16 and Eph. 5:19.** Are Christians commanded to sing? Read Zeph. 3:17 and Heb. 2:12. Had you considered that God sings, and you are made in His image?

 **2** How does singing "unify" a congregation?"

 **3** **Read aloud some of the lyrics from a Christian worship song.** Talk about what the song is about and why Christians might choose to sing this particular song. Spend some time discussing why on some occasions people sing rather than speak to God. The following song was written by Martin Luther in 1529 and has been sung by Christians for over 500 years. What is the message of this song, and why has it blessed Christians in so many contexts?
